- (ii) A matter which, based on existing facts and circumstances, presents significant exposure to litigation against the Commission (Gov. Code, § 11126, subd. (e)(2)(B));

- (iii) A matter which, based on existing facts and circumstances, the Commission is deciding whether to initiate litigation (Gov. Code, § 11126, subd. (e)(2)(C).); or

- (iv) Consideration of the appointment, employment, or evaluation of performance about a public employee. (Gov. Code, § 11126, subd. (a).)


