Comments provided at the workshop and through comments provided online and at the future WAC meeting by members of the public and interested stakeholders will help to inform what possible changes may be considered by Governing Board Members at a future Governing Board Meeting. The Governing Board may choose to schedule a subsequent workshop at a future Governing Board Meeting.

 - (iii) Consideration of the appointment, employment, or evaluation of performance about a public employee. (Gov. Code, § 11126, subd. (a).)


