



- **Promote:** SMBNEP helps to accomplish the project by actively campaigning for, and/or helping to disseminate information, etc. for the associated activities.
- **Support:** SMBNEP advocates for the project or activity by adopting policy statements, offering endorsements, providing supporting letters, testimony, etc.




BRP Revision Participants



BRP Revision Driven by:

Overhaul on goals needed in the context of progress and new factors such as the inclusion of climate change and CCVA as new priority area; new inclusion of performance measures

EPA role: confirm that the products meet guidance docs, provide input and suggestions, ultimately concur with revised BRP





NEW BRP Plan Components: EPA Guidance



Example GB input from last BRP Workshop:

- Prioritize habitat restoration projects
- Conduct more beach and dune restoration projects to increase adaptive capacity / resilience of coastline to climate change
- Conduct more kelp forest restoration projects
- Restore LAX Dunes
- Adopt a Final EIS/R plan for Ballona Wetlands Restoration Project within 5 years
- Consider watershed management improvements to reduce nutrient inputs into coastal systems
- Increase information sharing within SMBNEP project area and along west coast, i.e. management plans, monitoring data, education/outreach materials etc.
- Alter current BRP urban greening projects so that they are multi-benefit
