

SMBRC Governing Board Meeting Minutes
February 21, 2019

Welcome and Introductions

At 9:40 a.m., Fran Diamond called the meeting to order. Introductions followed.

1. Comments from Members of the Public on Items Not on the Agenda and Public Testimony on All Agenda Items

Public Comment:

Kathy Knight commented on Ballona wetlands restoration.

2. Informational Items

a) Order of Agenda

b) Report from the Chair

There was no report from the chair.

c) Reports from the Technical Advisory Committee

Steve Bay reported that the Technical Advisory Committee had not met since the last quarterly meeting in September. No next meeting scheduled yet.

d) Reports from the Chief Administrative Director and SMBNEP Staff

Guangyu Wang reported on the distribution of the e-survey for the governance structure of SMBNEP and reminded members the deadline for returning the survey is March 4. Wang also gave an update on the status of projects recommended for Prop 12 funding and invited Kara Kemmler to report on the schedule to take the recommended projects to the Coastal Conservancy Board in March for final approval.

Guangyu Wang mentioned that there were two errors in the previously adopted Governing Board 2019 meeting dates and recommended that the meeting dates for August and October be moved from fourth Thursday back to third Thursdays of the month. Laurie Newman suggested to keep the October meeting date on the fourth Thursday due to third Thursday's conflict with Coastal Connection event. Guangyu Wang said he will e-mail members after confirmation of date change.

Tom Ford gave the SMBNEP staff report. He reported on marine, wetlands, and community engagement programs and projects being carried out under the current annual workplan as well as an update on Coastal Research Institute.

In response to Board member request, Tom asked Melodie Grubbs to report on LAX Dunes restoration project.

a) Consideration of Approval of December 13, 2018 Meeting Minutes
