These comments will be compiled with comments received by Executive Committee members at this workshop. In addition, members of the public and interested stakeholders will have an opportunity at the next Watershed Advisory Council (WAC) Meeting on January 24, 2019 to provide comments concerning possible changes to the SMBNEP's partnership structure. Comments provided at the workshop and through comments provided online and at the future WAC meeting by members of the public and interested stakeholders will help to inform what possible changes may be considered by Governing Board Members at a future Governing Board Meeting. The Executive Committee may choose to schedule a subsequent workshop at a future Governing Board Meeting.

  - ii) A matter which, based on existing facts and circumstances, the Commission is deciding whether to initiate litigation (Gov. Code, § 11126, subd. (e)(2)(C).);  
or
  - iii) Consideration of the appointment, employment, or evaluation of performance about a public employee. (Gov. Code, § 11126, subd. (a).)
